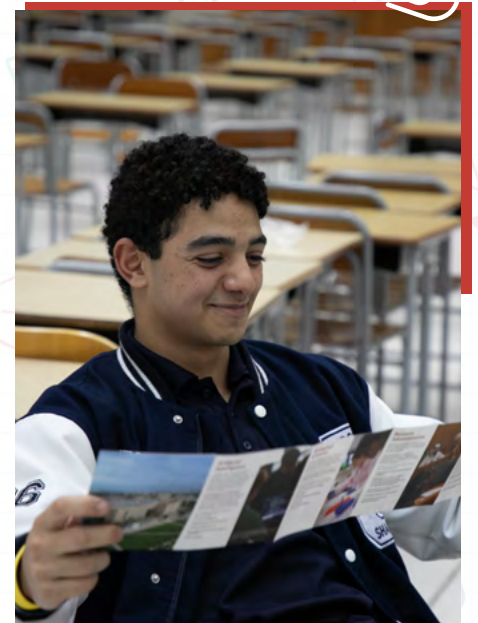

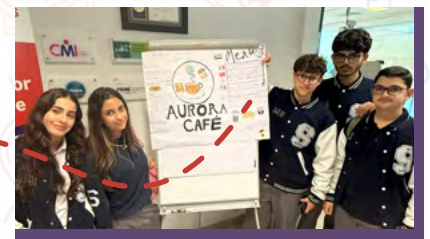
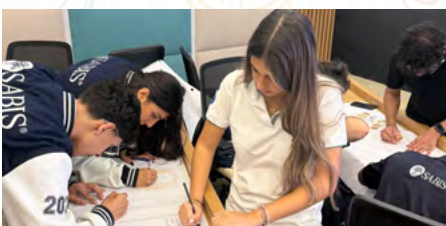


Business Day Camp 2025

They represented ISC-Sharjah at the RTA Dubai World Congress for Self-Driving Transport, engaging with global leaders in autonomous systems, sustainability, and smart mobility. Their participation at the Evolve Future Mobility Show 2025 at Expo Centre Sharjah further expanded their footprint in the U.A.E.'s green-mobility ecosystem.

During the summer, members completed internships with Global EEE and Al Nabooda Automobiles, gaining hands-on exposure to advanced automotive systems. The team also hosted the Certified EVGP STEM Educator Program, where their mentor, Mr. Davide Farina, and three students earned technical certifications.
