ISC-Sharjah Engineering Excellence Across EVGP and SABIS® STEAM Competition

This year, our team competed in both the EVGP and STEAM programs, undertaking the full lifecycle of building a fully functional electric vehicle, from initial concept and system architecture to engineering refinement and final execution. The process demanded disciplined design thinking, structural precision, and continuous performance optimization under competitive conditions.





Within the STEAM program, where rankings are determined through comprehensive judicial evaluation of vehicle quality, performance efficiency, innovation, and technical execution, we secured 1st place for the second consecutive year. Achieving this distinction twice reflects not only capability, but sustained consistency at the highest level of competition.

At EVGP, our engineering performance extended beyond the existing award framework. In response to the depth and structural sophistication of our vehicle, the organizers introduced a new distinction, the Best Engineering Award, created specifically to recognize the exceptional technical precision, advanced structural design, and engineering rigor demonstrated by our team. This recognition underscored that our work exceeded standard competitive benchmarks.



In addition, we earned 1st place in Technical Innovation and 1st place in AI Integration, alongside 2nd place in 3D Printing, reinforcing our ability to integrate advanced technologies with disciplined engineering execution.

With this foundation, we look ahead to the coming year with clear intent, to return stronger, push technical boundaries further, and continue raising the standard we have established.

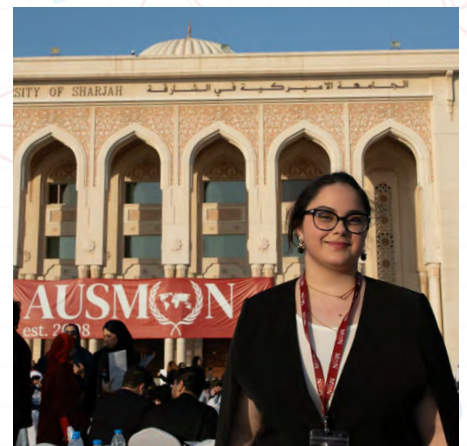
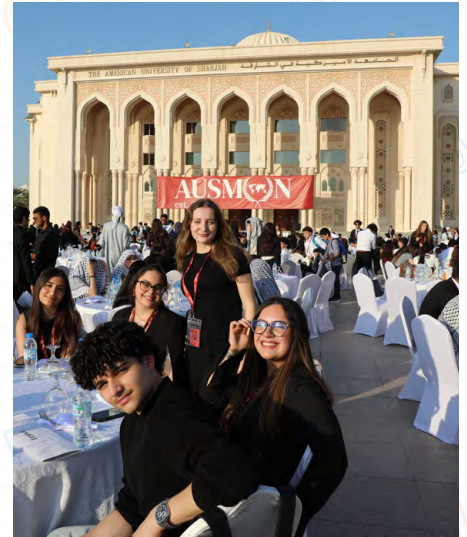
